FAQ's

Can I bring a bag into FIFA Fan Festival™ Boston?

Clear bags at or below the dimensions of 12" x 6" x 12" are permitted, as are diaper bags and medical-related bags. All bags are subject to search upon entry. There will not be storage services for declined bags. For the full list of prohibited items, please see [here](#).

Can I bring a water bottle into FIFA Fan Festival™ Boston?

Empty, refillable water bottles are permitted. Metal and glass water bottles are not permitted. For the full list of prohibited items, please see [here](#).

Can I bring food and/or drinks into FIFA Fan Festival™ Boston?

Food and drink items are not permitted, unless required for medical purposes. Any permitted food items must not be packaged in glass containers. For the full list of prohibited items, please see [here](#).

Are there ADA accommodations at FIFA Fan Festival™ Boston?

The site is ADA compliant and there will be space allocated for wheelchair users and their companions. There is an ADA compliant drop-off location near both the Cambridge Street and Congress Street entrances to the site.

FIFA Fan Festival™ Boston will be hosted at Boston City Hall Plaza, 1 City Hall Square, Boston, MA 02203, United States.

Do any age restrictions on entry apply at FIFA Fan Festival™ Boston?

Please note that children under the age of 13 must be accompanied into FIFA Fan Festival™ Boston by an adult.

Is FIFA Fan Festival™ Boston free? How do I get my pass(es)?

Boston's FIFA Fan Festival™ Boston is free and open to the public. All attendees must register in advance to obtain a free general admission digital pass. The pass is required for access but does not guarantee entry to the Festival, as admission is subject to capacity. Register for your pass [now](#).

How do I receive my FIFA Fan Festival™ Boston Pass(es)?

Your digital pass will be sent to the email address provided in the primary passholder's Boston26 Web App account. Delivery of passes via email will start soon. Once you receive your pass by email, we strongly encourage you to add your pass(es) to your mobile wallet for quick and easy scanning upon arrival. Remember the pass does not guarantee entry – it will be on a first come first served basis.

What if I did not receive my FIFA Fan Festival™ Boston Pass(es)?

First, please check your inbox (and even your junk or spam folder, just in case) for an email from noreply@wrstbnd.com. It's a good idea to add that email to your safe senders list or contacts so you don't miss any important updates.

Is re-entry allowed?

Your pass is valid only for the day/time identified. Once you exit the site, you will not be able to re-enter with the same pass.

Can I use cash to purchase food, drinks, merchandise, etc. at the FIFA Fan Festival™ Boston?

FIFA Fan Festival™ Boston is a cashless venue. All vendors including the food and beverage concessions accept all international debit and credit cards, Visa® is preferred. Only contactless payment options will be accepted within the venue. Fans can utilize a Cash-to-Card kiosk within the venue to convert cash to Visa® prepaid cards.

What security screening should I expect at FIFA Fan Festival™ Boston?

FIFA Fan Festival™ Boston will have a fenced perimeter, and all guests will be subject to security screening protocols, including metal detectors and a clear bag policy. See below for the full list of prohibited items:

Is FIFA Fan Festival™ Boston family-friendly?

Absolutely! There are plenty of activities for attendees of all ages - including games, family-friendly food and drink options, and more! Children under the age of 13 must be accompanied into FIFA Fan Festival™ Boston by an adult.

How do I get to FIFA Fan Festival™ Boston?

If you are traveling locally, please walk and cycle if you can. Check-out the location of nearby cycle bike parking [here](#). Alternatively, the city's [Bluebikes](#) bike share system could be a good option though note some temporary changes to docking station locations are in place during the event.

If you are traveling from further away, please use public transportation. You can take any subway line or a bus route below:

- Green Line to Government Center(at City Hall Plaza)
- Blue Line to Government Center (at City Hall Plaza)
- Orange Line to State or Haymarket (each about a 5-minute walk)
- Red Line to Downtown Crossing (about a 10-minute walk), or transfer to the Green Line at Park Street
- Bus routes 92 or 93 to Congress St @ North St (at City Hall Plaza)

Will food and drink be available on-site?

Yes! FIFA Fan Festival™ Boston will feature a variety of local and regional cuisines. Food and beverage options are for purchase.

What are the rules around alcohol purchase?

You must be 21 or older to purchase or consume alcohol. As required by state law you may be asked to show Government issued photo ID. International visitors in particular are advised that, if you do not possess a US issued driver's license or other US issued ID, you must be ready to show your passport.

Can I register multiple people?

Yes! You can register your friends and family for their passes. Please keep in mind that you can only register for 6 passes at a single time. Children under the age of 18 must have a waiver signed by a parent or legal guardian to enter. Children under the age of 13 must be accompanied into FIFA Fan Festival™ Boston by an adult.
